About Our Camp

The Nature Discovery Camp is for 3, 4 and 5 1/2 year old children.

- A child must have had his/her 3rd birthday by January 1 and should have pre-school experience.
- The entire registration fee is due by June 1 or your child's space will be given to another camper.
- Registration can be dropped off or mailed to the Arboretum by March 31
- Notification of acceptance will be made by phone on April 1st.
- Lunch Bunch is an optional lunch program and/or for five Mondays or five Wednesdays during the camp from 11:30am-1:00pm. Additional fee for one session is \$125 or \$225 for both sessions.

Creating choices enables the child to explore their innate curiosity towards the environmental sciences.

The Idea of a Nature Discovery Camp

To create in young children a positive interest in nature and to encourage a protective attitude toward living things. The naturally beautiful surroundings of the Arboretum allow children to learn to appreciate the environment around them. Activities stressing the interdependence of plants and animals introduce children to the value of relationships in nature. Hands-on discovery sparks children's natural curiosity and joy in learning. A variety of creative activities will be planned each week that will incorporate the arts and sciences.
